### 1) COMPONENTS:

Vehicle: Natural vegetable gums, water, additives, and preservatives under the threshold limit requiring warnings.

Pigments: Mineral and Organic pigments.

#### 2-1) CADMIUM PIGMENTS:

Colours #208 Cad. Orange, 210 Cad. Red Deep, 211 Cad. Red Medium, 212 Cad. Red Light, 213 Cad. Scarlet, 215 Cad. Yellow Deep, 216 Cad. Yellow Medium, 217 Cad. Yellow Light, 218 Cad. Yellow Lemon, 259 Naples Yellow.

**WARNING: CONTAINS CADMIUM PIGMENT/ SOLUBLE CADMIUM.**

These colours are: #229 Cerulean Blue, 238 Cobalt Turquoise, 253 Manganese Blue, 254 Manganese Violet, 290 Viridian Green.

3) FIRST AID MEASURES:

FIRST AID FOR EYES: Flush immediately under running water for fifteen minutes.

If redness or irritation occurs, seek medical attention.

FIRST AID FOR SKIN: Avoid prolonged contact with skin. Wash with soap and water.

FIRST AID FOR INGESTION: Small ingested amounts are not expected to produce adverse health effects. Induce vomiting if person is conscious. Call a physician.

Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Paint has a PH value = 7 to 7.5
